MATTERS ARISING:

### **Drainage at Park and Main Street**

Cllr Barrera had been advised there were issues with the contractor so any work may take longer than planned. Notwithstanding this, it was acknowledged that FC has done a good job on the burn and there has been no flooding to date.

### **Community Centre Update**

The Community Council met with Fife Council and while there is no possibility of £86,000 being available, we may be able to utilise the £45,000 planning gain to do some of the work.

### **Lochwood Park Entrance Sign**

Still waiting for work to be carried out.

### **Church Street Parking**

Cllr Pryde advised he had received no update or proposed plan for this. He will investigate the two disabled parking spaces currently in the street but no longer used and see if at least one of them can be removed.

### **Planning Gain Funds**

As discussed earlier, FC is going to see if we can use these funds to improve the Community Centre.

### **Local Place Plans**

The Community Council agreed to use the work carried out by the Coal Regeneration Fund and although Forbes and Norman attended a Zoom meeting, there has been no response since.
