MATTERS ARISING

FINANCE:

After discussion it was agreed that Margaret would reduce our grant request to £5780 to include an amount of £500 for KASH should it be requested.

PARK DRAINAGE/PLAN

Still waiting to hear from FC. The CC is holding £2000 for the cost of the drainage plans but no invoice has been forthcoming after a period of almost two years. Helen will set up a meeting of all relevant parties for early November in order to progress this work. It was noted that we are also still waiting for the MUGA plans and costs and Helen said she would chase this up. The meeting will also address the flooding in home owners' gardens who back onto the park.

YOUTH GROUP

No report to hand.

FREW PLACE UPDATE:

A lot of hard work has been ongoing in the community garden and it was agreed that the remaining money for the project will be spent as seen necessary by those carrying out the work. Helen will get back to us regarding relocating two sheds from the bowling green to the community garden for storage.

CERTAIN AGE CLUB:

Sheila and Forbes will sort out the annual afternoon tea separately.

COALFIELD REGENERATION ACTION PLAN:

As part of our action plan included updating the community centre, Helen Law will ask whether this is possible. We are hoping to have windows installed and the ceiling height lowered. Helen also asked how we would feel about having a key holder in the village to make access simpler during any period of emergency. Everyone agreed that this was a good idea.

CHRISTMAS LIGHTS:

Helen will find out if we can access the Community Centre for an electric supply for the Christmas tree. If not, we may have to revert to the solar lights which were not great last year.
